REACH DECLARATION

REACH REGULATIONS

REACH (Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006) is European Union legislation which regulates suppliers of chemicals or products ("articles") into the European Economic Area.

In summary REACH requires companies:

- That supply chemicals to pre-register and/or register the chemicals and their uses.
- That supply articles to inform recipients if an article contains a Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC) in excess of 0.1% by weight.
- To notify the European Chemical Agency (ECHA) beginning December 1, 2010 if an article placed on the European market contains any SVHC in excess of 0.1% by weight and the SVHC's in such articles exceed one metric ton.

COMPLIANCE

e2v, Inc., supplies semiconductors into world markets including the European Economic Area. These semiconductors are "articles" as defined in the regulation.

The SVHC list, updated by the ECHA on January 20, 2016, has been reviewed and none of the SVHC chemicals are present in e2v, Inc.'s semiconductor products or packaging in concentrations of more than 0.1 percent.
